CONDO CHALLENGE:

The owners of this Kaneohe condo wanted the living room and bathrooms to feel more open, light and airy. The primary bathroom had only a small vanity, single sink and very little storage. Outdated jalousie louver windows and wooden doors in the living room made the space appear dark and confined.



CONDO SOLUTION:

“Mirrors are the single easiest way to make a room look and feel larger,” explains Gueric de Coligny of The Glass Guru of Honolulu. The homeowners placed a large, framed mirror near their corner window to reflect the view of Kaneohe Bay. Modern glass windows and sliding doors let natural light flow from the lanai. The master bathroom was reconfigured with an expanded double vanity, oversized wall mirrors, and glass shower panels and enclosures. “Whether it’s a simple single panel or a large full enclosure, shower glass ‘disappears’ to make the room feel larger and shows off your tile and bathroom design elements.”

Top 3 Condo Design Tips:

1. Use big wall mirrors to expand views and create the illusion of doubling your room area.
2. Glass showers can make bathrooms feel more spacious. Glass can also be used in other areas for a modern, luxurious feel — think backsplashes in your kitchen or bar, on tabletops, inside cabinetry and shelving, as interior and exterior railings, and lanai doors.
